

GEIDAI Account Password Rules



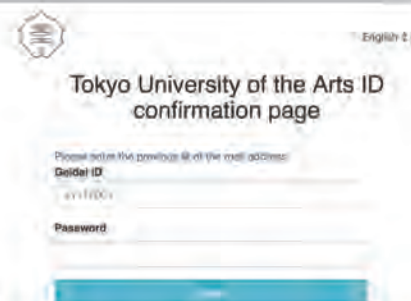
Various information services cannot be accessed with the initial password shown on the account information form. When you receive your account information form, please change your password by visiting the website mentioned below.



Tokyo University of the Arts ID confirmation (Login) page:

When you access this site,
the ID confirmation page will be displayed.



Your password will expire in one year from the date it is changed.
An email will be sent to notify you before your password expires.

When your password is about to expire or if it has already expired,
please change it by visiting the Tokyo University of the Arts ID confirmation (Login) page.

On the Tokyo University of the Arts ID confirmation page, you can set up a secondary email address.
If you set up a secondary email address, you will be able to use it to reset the password for your primary email address in case you ever forget it.

If you cannot log in to your GEIDAI account:

Q1) Do you enter your GEIDAI ID correctly?

Your GEIDAI ID is "s" + your student ID number (note that "s" is lowercase). It is not necessary to add anything after the "@" in your email address when logging in to any information system other than Gmail.

The complete email address is required for accessing your GEIDAI email (Gmail) account, and for any other information system, the GEIDAI ID is enough.

Q2) Are you regularly changing your password?

If your password expires, you will not be able to log in.

Even if you are not sure of your password's expiration date, please try changing your password first.

Q3) Do you remember your secondary email address?

In case you remember the secondary email address that you registered

Please click on "[If you forget your password](#)" from the "HELP" link on the Tokyo University of the Arts ID confirmation page. You will be able to reset your password.

In case you do not remember your secondary email address or have not registered one yet

Please click on "[To the application page \(password reissue\)](#)" from the "HELP" link on the Tokyo University of the Arts ID confirmation page. Please check the reply email from Art Media Center for the reissued password.

[GEIDAI Account]

Your GEIDAI account is required to register for classes and to utilize the information services within GEIDAI. The main information services that are available with your GEIDAI account are as follows:

- GEIDAI Email (Gmail)
- Services incidental to Gmail, Including Google Classroom
- Academic Affairs System (Campus Plan) ※Please contact the Student Affairs Office for details.
- Library Information Service ※Please contact the library for details.
- On-Campus LAN Remote Access (VPN Connection) Service
- Wireless LAN Connection Service

※Please ensure that you change the password for your GEIDAI account once a year.

In the following cases, please consult the Art Media Center through your supervisor.

- When connecting communication devices such as, (wireless LAN devices, network attached storage HDDs, network printers, etc.) to the university network
- When building websites on the geidai.ac.jp domain.

There are many cases of network problems due to the connecting of unauthorized wireless LAN devices. Please ensure that you apply for permission before using your device.

[Laboratory, Editing Room, and Seminar Room]

We have installed computers as well as the latest peripherals and are offering a creative environment for new art and media expressions in the fields of music, art, and film and new media. Specialized staff will lend their support. Both students and faculty members of this university are free to use the equipment. However, in order to use certain facilities and equipment, it may be necessary to take part in regular workshops in order to obtain the requisite qualifications.

To use these facilities, it is mandatory that you sign up for liability insurance (at the co-op store or at the Student Affairs Office).

Laboratory = Large equipment (fabrication and sound systems) are available for use, and some of equipment are rentable.

Editing room = Computers for image and video editing are available for use.

Seminar room = When classes are not in session, you can use the computers with Mac / Windows dual-boot functionality.

[Main Facilities / Equipment]

Computers for image / video editing, scanners (A3 size), large-format printers, various types of cutting machines (including laser cutters and cutting plotters), 3D printers, UV printer, book binding machines, sound studio, and more.

[Main Equipment for Loan]

Video cameras, single lens reflex cameras, tripods, projectors, screens, speakers, microphones / voice recorders, displays, etc.

[Hours of Operation]

Laboratory, Editing Room: Weekdays, 11:00-19:00

(You can use the equipment until 18:30)

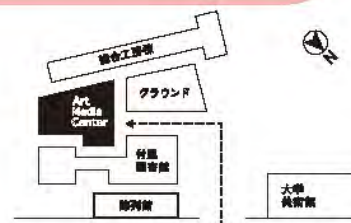
Seminar Room: Weekdays, 11:00-19:00

AMC 利用に伴う保険加入について Insurance requirements for using the AMC

本学の学生が芸術情報センターのサービスを利用をするには、1. 学生賠償責任保険または2+a. 学生教育研究災害傷害保険および学研災付帯賠償責任保険または2+b. 学生教育研究災害傷害保険および外国人留学生向け学研災付帯学生生活総合保険いずれかの加入が必須です。1. 学生賠償責任保険については利用する機会がなくても、期間終了の際に手続きを行えば料金の一部は返金されます。保険加入方法に関しては、以下の表を元にそれぞれの部署で相談してください。

Those who wish to use equipment at the Art Media Center (AMC) must be enrolled in one of the following insurance plans:

1. Personal Liability Insurance for Students (Gakubai)

Insurer: UNIV. CO-OP

This insurance is available to members of the University Co-op. In addition to the premium, a deposit for membership will be required, which will be refunded upon termination of the insurance contract.

2+a. Personal Accident Insurance for Students Pursuing Education and Research (Gakkensai) and Insurance for accidents involving third parties or their property (Futaibaiseki)

Insurer: Japan Educational Exchanges and Services (JEES)

This combination of insurance gives you liability coverage during regular curricular activities, school events, etc.

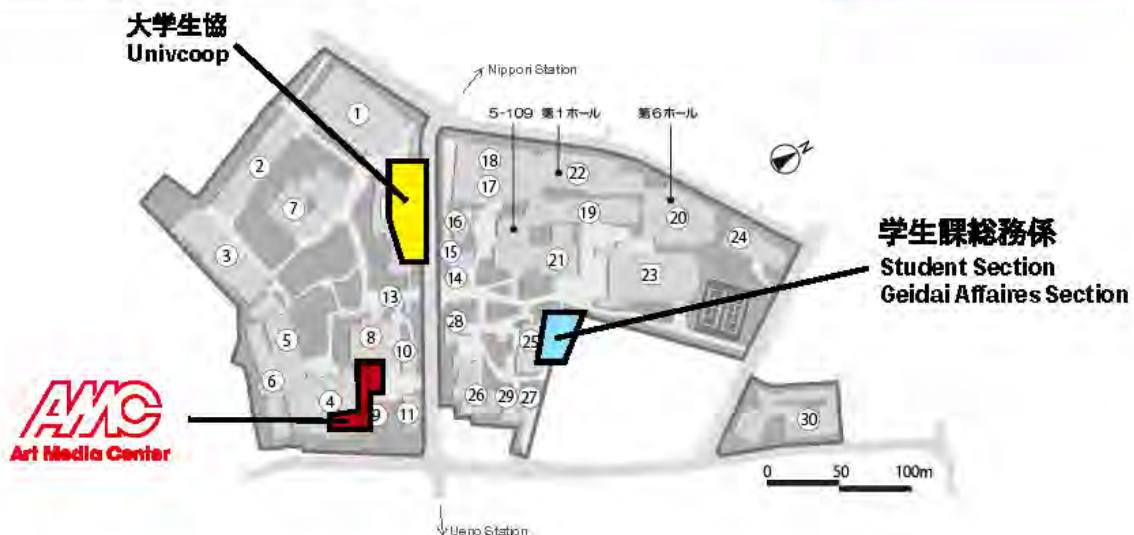
2+b. Comprehensive Insurance for Students Lives Coupled with "Gakkensai" for International Students

Insurer: Japan Educational Exchanges and Services (JEES)

This insurance policy provides broad coverage, including personal liability and medical expenses. Assistance is available in English.
